

A river cruise may hold up to 200 passengers on their ship compared to an ocean line cruise which can hold up to 3000 or more passengers. A river cruise allows you to stay in port longer. The ship will dock in the city and stay there most of the day, sometimes even into the night. Some ships travel at night to get from city to city as some ports are only three hours apart.


