



A rainy day is still a great day at an All-inclusive Resort.



TIP #7 WI-FI SERVICE



Expect Wi-Fi to be Spotty. Most Resorts offer Wi-Fi in your room but if it doesn't come standard with your room you can usually purchase it and the cost is usually very affordable. Most resorts do offer Wi-Fi in certain areas around the resort like the lobby or maybe the coffee shop. So if you aren't working and you don't mind walking to make your phonecalls or check emails you won't need Wi-Fi in your room. YOU ARE ON VACTION, just relax and enjoy your time.

A good tip is when in a foreign country always leave your phone on Air-Plane mode so you don't have roaming charges. With most cell phone services if you are on Wi-Fi plus airplane mode you should not receive any roaming charges but always check with your phone carrier to see what your options are and what your coverage includes.
